## eTicket Guide

HOW TO SELECT AND ACCESS YOUR eTickets

### What is an eTicket?

"eTicket" refers to a ticket which is available as a Mobile Ticket or a Print-at-Home ticket.

Mobile Tickets are viewable on the Ticketmaster App as a QR coded ticket.

- These tickets can be shown on your phone at the venue with no need to print.
- They can be shown directly via the App or, for iPhone users only, can be saved to the Apple Wallet and easily brought up for display at the venue.

Print-at-Home tickets are viewable and downloadable as a PDF ticket with a barcode.

- They can be viewed and downloaded from ticketmaster.com.au, either on desktop or on a mobile or tablet browser.
- These tickets MUST be printed and taken to the venue as a physical copy.



## How do I Select eTicket as a Delivery Method?


eTicket is only available as a delivery method on certain events, and is often dependent on the infrastructure and scanning technology at the venue.

For eligible events, eTicket can be selected as a delivery option when booking on:

- Desktop
- Mobile device
- The Ticketmaster App

If you cannot see the eTicket option, eTicket is not available for the event you are booking.



Mail Free

Ticketmaster will mail these within 2 business days of the booking. Tickets usually arrive within 5 - 7 days of posting.

#### Outlet Pickup Free

From any Outlet nationally up to 24 hours prior to your event. Please refer to Outlet locations for details. All Outlet Pickup tickets must be collected and personally signed for by the credit card holder who is the only person authorised to collect tickets. For identification purposes the credit card holder must present personal ID, the credit card which was used when purchasing the tickets and the account confirmation number.

#### Mamma Mia! Branded Gift B... \$8.95

Let us take care of gift wrapping your tickets with this exclusive Mamma Mial branded gift box. Select this delivery method to have your tickets sent to you in a Mamma Mial themed gift box, ideal for gifting tickets for a special occasion. Tickets cannot be sent directly to the gift recipient but will be sent to your billing address.

#### Registered Post \$6.50

Ticketmaster will mail these within 2 business days of the booking. Under Australia Post rules, you will need to allow 14 days delivery time for this method. When collecting tickets sent by Registered Post from the Post Office, a signature and

## Selecting eTicket on Ticketmaster App


On the Ticketmaster App, eTicket is the default delivery option.

To change delivery options or view details, the customer can click on "eTicket – Free". This will then bring up a screen which will allow them to change their option – see right.

### **Accessing eTickets**

eTickets can be accessed in multiple ways.

- Desktop tickets will display as a PDF Print-at-Home ticket
- Mobile Browser (Smartphone or Tablet) tickets will display as a PDF Print-at-Home ticket
- Ticketmaster App tickets will display as a QR coded Mobile Ticket




## Accessing eTickets on a Desktop

To access PDF Print-at-Home tickets via a desktop or laptop computer:

- Log in to your MyTicketmaster account.
- Navigate to the "View All Orders" page.
- Select "Order Details" for the order you wish to print.
- Select "View Tickets".
- This will bring up a PDF copy of the tickets to be saved to your PC or printed.

These tickets must be printed an a physical copy taken to the venue.



## Accessing eTickets on a Mobile Browser


Because the Ticketmaster website has now been mobile-optimised, the website accessed via mobile devices is the same site as the desktop site.

Accessing tickets works in the same way as on desktop.

Access your tickets via your Order page.

You can then save PDF to your phone, print directly from your phone, or bookmark the tickets to print later.

PDF Print-at-Home tickets cannot be shown on a mobile at the venue and must be printed.





# Accessing eTickets on the Ticketmaster App

To access your Mobile Tickets on the Ticketmaster App:

- Ensure you are logged in on the App
- Click on "My Events" on the bottom toolbar
- Select the event for which you'd like to view tickets
- This will then bring up a summary of your order for that event
- Click "View" on the first ticket in the order

This will then show you all tickets you have purchased for that order.

iPhone users can save these tickets to the Apple Wallet if they wish.

## Adding to Your Wallet


iPhone users with the Ticketmaster App can add their QR coded Mobile Tickets to their Apple Wallet for easy access later or at the venue.

This is currently only available for iPhone users.



## Adding to Your Wallet







- Access the ticket in the App as per usual
- Click on the "Add to Apple Wallet" icon on the ticket
- Your iPhone will prompt you to confirm that you would like to add these passes to your Wallet - click "Add"
- Navigate to your Wallet app from your home screen of your phone
- You should now be able to see your ticket in your wallet

Tickets saved in your wallet should be shown on your phone and not as a printed copy.
